

Funding for manufacturing energy efficiency equipment upgrades and metering projects

Funding for any large energy efficiency equipment upgrades



\$16 million

in funding over three years to help manufacturers save energy and money

- Funding available to:
 - Upgrade energy monitoring systems,
 - Replace or retrofit old, inefficient equipment with new energy efficient equipment,
 - Improve manufacturing processes.

Who can apply

- Australian Business Number (ABN) and be registered for GST
- Eligible if you manufacture product and your project relates to that process
- Site must be located in NSW
- Businesses can apply for multiple sites



Round 1: Up to \$120,000 per site



Round 1 closed 31 July, the next funding offer will be available later this year.

Metering and process optimisation (Offer 1) \$50k matched

Simple energy efficiency upgrades (Offer 2a) \$30k matched

Large energy efficiency upgrades (Offer 2b) \$70k matched

Prove the benefit of metering and give businesses the tools to manage their energy

Help businesses get quick wins through simple upgrades with minimal paperwork

Support businesses that want to do more complex projects and see the savings





Energy coaching for small business

Energy coaching for small business

- 1-1 coaching for businesses to identify ways to save energy and money.
- 2 hours of coaching from an energy expert face to face or via video conference.
- \$400 worth of coaching for a \$20 business investment

Energy project coaching

- Subsidised one-on-one expert coaching for businesses to identify ways to save energy and money
- Up to \$3,000 of support to:
 - scope your energy efficiency project
 - get your project ready for the Manufacturing Efficiency Funding application
 - develop your energy efficiency project business case for only \$300.*

Benchmark and support for energy intensive manufacturers

Improve strategic approach to energy management through a free benchmarking assessment and tailored support from our panel of energy experts.


- **Step 1:** The **free** assessment evaluates how your business is currently performing and identifies priorities to be targeted.

Pilot projects

NSW Energy Savings Scheme (ESS)



- NSW's largest energy efficiency program
- The scheme creates between \$50M and \$100M in incentives for energy efficiency projects every year
- Individual incentives are based on the amount of energy saved
- Industrial projects often require energy savings to be verified

Eligible upgrades include, but are not limited, to:

- Lighting
- Refrigeration
- Hot water and steam systems
- o Motors, fans and pumps
- o Process change and control system upgrades
- NABERS rating improvements
- Compressed air systems
- Power systems
- Furnaces
- Bundled upgrades


Climate Change Adaptation
